A Swiss connection with Bayaria


Complete trains of SBB stock run from Zürich to München via Lindau through the linked valleys of the Allgäu in southern Bavaria, rising to some 2000 feet near Oberstaufen, an ancient small town on the Salt Road from Hall-in-Tirol to notherne Europe. Large parts of the valley resemble the Emmental in Switzerland. This must have struck a Swiss citizen

who, in 1827, established the manufacture here of Emmental chees. this is now a significant industry.

The Emmental breed of cows seem to be less evident in Switzerland today so, if you want to see them in abundance and enjoy excellent cheese, go to the Allgäu!
