RhB Clarification and Information. I have just been reading my article 'Autumn on the Rhätische Bahn' in the December *Swiss Express* and I spotted an interesting typo of my own making. I referred to a train from Landeck to St Moritz via the Engadin, when I should have put LANDQUART to St Moritz... No, they haven't built the once proposed extension into Austria while I've been looking the other way!

In the same article I noted that I was unsure of the extent of the 'switchable catenary' at Pontresina. Fellow SRS member Adrian Friend has kindly confirmed that both Platform 2 and the adjacent through line at the station have the necessary switchable electrical supply arrangements to allow trains arriving, using 11,000v AC, to switch to 1,000v DC - and the other way. The voltage is shown by indicators under the platform canopy and adjacent to the protecting signals. I had not been aware of these signals, which are shown here thanks to Adrian. There is also a 'blank' display that is shown when the lines are not electrified.
