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Germany

Germany has always been one of Switzerland's principal buyers. Once more, the Western zone is an interesting commercial partner for Switzerland, although trade between the two countries is very unevenly balanced. (During the first nine months of this year, Germany exported 707.1 millions of Swiss francs' worth of goods to

Switzerland but only imported 316.4 millions of francs' worth of Swiss goods.) However notice should be called to the interest shown by German buyers in Swiss clothing and fabrics. We shall be going into this in more detail in subsequent numbers of this periodical ; we merely wished to draw attention here to the interesting position gained by Swiss textiles on the German market, thanks to their outstanding quality.
