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IN PRAISE OF READY-MADE WEAR

« Ready-Made » is the term applied to all apparel serially manufactured in opposition to custom-cut garments. The term used to have, and still has for some people, a somewhat disdainful implication. When, in the old days, a man was said to wear a « ready-made » suit, it was implied that he was badly dressed.

Nevertheless, since the opening years of the present century, there has been a swift development in this respect, an evolution accelerated by two World Wars. We have no intention of tracing the very profound changes which have revolutionized social life, morals and customs ; however, without pretence of giving a complete history of this revolution or of specifying in detail the importance of each factor, we can try to enumerate a few of the causes which, in one way or another, have contributed to form present-day taste in clothing.

Firstly, there has been a definite return, if not to Nature, at least to open-air life, that is to say to active, physical pleasures, to sport considered as an antidote to the overmechanization to which many of us must submit in our daily work. And here, we must pause to mention the enormous influence the cinema, and American films especially, have exercised on public life.

Without going more deeply into the matter, we find here two major causes which have determined the evolution of dress in our times, at least as regards its industrial manufacture. The need has been felt firstly to wear practical clothing, giving great freedom of movement ; secondly, to have outfits perfectly adapted to practical requirements for the pursuit of certain sports or activities. Then, there has also been a desire — on the part of men as well as of women — to be able to wear decent « civil » clothes in social life, clothes which bear no reminder of one's daily occupation, clothes which are as elegant as those worn by the film stars. Indubitably, one of the merits of the American film industry has been to awaken the taste for smart, correct clothing in the mind of the general public. In the old days, only the members of the aristocracy and the wealthy middle-classes wore custom-made clothes ; the working classes had to be content with slops. Fashion then was a question of class. « Ladies » patronized fashion houses or a little dressmaker who « sewed like an angel » either at her own or her customers' homes... and everyone felt satisfied with the arrangement ! But then, fashions changed so slowly.

Today, feminine fashions change every season, and all women — whether or not they are wage-earners — want to be smart ; men too feel that they must change their clothes after the day's work is done. On the other hand, the love of physical movement, the practice of all kinds of sports, create a need for special types of clothing, many of which must meet certain technical requirements which only industrial production can satisfy. Consequently, the demand for ready-made apparel has increased and, as a result, Swiss industries in this branch have been able to develop and extend their activities.

The Swiss market itself presents some rather particular and interesting characteristics : its buying power is relatively large despite its somewhat limited consumption capacity ; ethnical and cultural diversity in the country itself has given rise to a great variety of tastes ; its industrial production is served by highly qualified labour and has thus made the Swiss consumer very exigent.

Swiss ready-made apparel is not therefore mass-produced. It is made first for the consumer on the home market, for a consumer who is used to quality in materials and workmanship. Only relatively small series of each article are manufactured, in order to allow for the different tastes of the population ; furthermore, both as regards standard and luxury articles, this Swiss industry gives the lie to the prejudice against « ready-made » garments. All its products meet the very severe exigencies of a clientele which naturally appreciates quality, and also desires good style and smartness, the same smartness that couturiers and first-class tailors confer in European and overseas fashion centres. It is not surprising, therefore, that the Swiss clothing industries should have turned towards export and have achieved the same success on foreign markets as in their own country. All those foreign buyers who come to Switzerland every season certainly come to look for quality goods, elegance, high quality fabrics, impeccable workmanship, whether in standard or very « fashionable novelty » lines, or for the usual outfitters' products. This also applies to underwear. Women today, whatever their financial means, all want to wear dainty underclothes of the kind that, in the old days, only fairy-fingered seamstresses and embroiderers could make — at a price ! Modern men, too, want practical, hygienic undergarments which fit well and comfortably. Shirts must be smart and well-tailored for wear without waistcoats under open summer jackets.

Perhaps some will say that outfitters cannot clothe everyone, that they cannot suit all types. Other objections also may be raised ; and some people will still say that a man or woman is badly dressed because they are wearing ready-made apparel. Well ! It certainly is not so ! The clothing industry cannot, of course, manufacture serially garments to fit dwarfs or giants, but it can supply standard, well-proportioned sizes which correspond to the average figure. And, besides, in Switzerland this industry is not equipped for mass-production, and it has maintained a certain individual note and can offer a sufficient range of choice to suit all normal tastes and requirements. Furthermore, by purchasing ready-made clothes, the buyer can see exactly what he is getting for his money ; he can try on, compare, examine workmanship, have alterations made ; he can finally leave the shop with a garment of impeccable cut and style, which pleases him in every way. Nor does he run the risk of experiencing an unpleasant shock when the time comes to pay the bill. That is why *today, the wearing of ready-made apparel implies « being well-dressed » and having the best value for one's money.*

Apparel and Underwear

From the viewpoint of dress, there seems to be three general types of women: some dream of smart gowns, tailormades and coats, or rather the outward effect of dress; others attach less importance to appearance, but like to wear only the most beautiful lingerie, silks, embroideries and laces; others again, always try to match the elegance of their lingerie to that of the outer garments. The modern apparel industry can satisfy the tastes of all these women, because its methods allow it to compete successfully with the neatness, care, delicacy, cut and fanciful detail of the most skilful seamstress of the pre-industrial era.

How is it that we can today find everything we want in the shops? In the old days, a family represented not only a complete consumption unit, but also a production unit; women used to carry on their own clothing industry, as it were – they all knew how to spin and weave, cut out, sew, embroider and knit, and could clothe their usually numerous family from head to foot entirely with products of their own work. Early in the 19th century, it seemed as though work were flowing out from the domestic circle and that women were following it into the outer world beyond... This was, in fact, the result of the introduction of mechanical looms. Today, there is a far greater division of labour than ever before and production is reaching an increasingly high degree of mechanization. «Ready-made» clothing dates back to the mid-19th century; the term signified garments which were no longer custom-tailored, according to individual requirements, but serially manufactured according to stand-



ards of taste, size and finish which would be appreciated by a very large class of customers.

The first factory in Switzerland to undertake the manufacture of ladies' underwear was founded in 1883 by Jacob Scherrer, whose wife had most intelligently foreseen that the time was coming when women would be employed in the most diverse occupations and that they would then prefer to buy ready-made apparel, rather than to make it at home. But where, in those days, could one find sufficiently skilful seamstresses, capable of working with machines. Work in a factory is so different from the peaceful, quiet rhythm of domestic crafts! The firm therefore imported a number of «cousettes» or Parisian seamstresses whose task it was to train Swiss working-girls.

The major factor in the apparel trade, is to perfect cut, style and finish to such a degree that each woman has the impression of buying a garment made exclusively for her and which will give her the best possible service as regards wear. Scherrer lingerie styles are studied and designed anew every season; in this way, every woman, tall or short, fat or thin, can find a garment which suits her; styles are always elegant – line and trimmings always correspond to the requirements of changing fashions and tastes. Details, too, are important – details which tend to be

forgotten and which even the buyer overlooks: finish and workmanship, seams, hems, straps . . . because the customer should not need needle and thread to touch up and mend continually; cut and style, the way in which the fabric is worked so that the lingerie can resist countless launderings without losing shape; trimmings, laces, smocking, embroideries—all are essential details. It is wear alone which reveals whether all these points have been considered by the manufacturer and carefully perfected. It is by wear alone that buyers gradually realize that their underwear is profitable and practical, easy to launder.

In 1934, Messrs. Scherrer added a new line to their manufacturing programme: dresses. In this field, the firm's main policy is to keep to one type of product, dresses in plain fabrics, smart and neat in style, for summer wear. Women who cannot imagine a summer dress except as prints or gauzy, light fabrics, learn that a plain dress, in tones ranging from bright to pastel shades, can be just as delightful. In these plain fabrics, faulty cut cannot be hidden by the pattern and styles must be impeccable in line and trimming. Plain frocks never "go out of fashion"; in reality, they are smarter than prints and enhance good dressmaking. The quality of the material, distinctive originality of style, perfection of cut – these alone can secure the popularity of the "plain, little frock." Other apparently negligible details too, have their importance; seams and hems must allow for alteration, buttons must be secure



and styles judiciously designed to suit all types of feminine figures. We feel confident that these "little" frocks will be a great success.

The same can be said for Marquesa ski jackets, launched as a novelty ten years ago at the time when skiing made its great leap into fame and became a popular sport. Everywhere on snowy descents and slopes, where ski fans throng, you will see these jackets in bright but never gaudy colours—tomato red, winter blue, lime, amber practical, sporty styles, zip fasteners, sensible pockets and hoods, useful and good to look at. Fancy and amusing buttons and pockets do not prevent these jackets from providing their wearers with most efficient protection against biting winds and bad weather. Marquesa jackets are made of impregnated cotton; their cut has been studied most carefully to allow perfect freedom of movement to the skier; they can be worn under any weather conditions. Most encouraging results have been obtained with these articles.

Another practical accessory for the skiing outfit are the neat little caps Messrs. Scherrer provide. They are perfectly adapted to winter sports requirements and can be worn over any style of hairdress. A cosy flap keeps the ears warm on bitterly cold days. Mitts to match complete the outfit.

In the opening lines of the present article, we spoke of three types of women. Those of the third group, the women who like smart clothes and lingerie, will certainly find enough to satisfy their exigencies in the collections presented by Messrs. Scherrer of Romanshorn, Switzerland.
