Jersey and knitted fabrics

During these last few years jersey and knitted fabrics have played an increasingly important role in women's clothing, whether for dresses, suits, two-pieces, skirts, pullovers, cardigans, jackets, slacks or other articles from the classic to the fancy.

Are recent improvements in the construction of knitting machines which enable an increasing variety of articles to be more easily manufactured responsible for this fashion, or has the demand inspired the designers of these machines to surpass themselves? We think that both have played their part but we do not intend to go any further into the question. What is important for us is to note the facts while proving by illustrations the extent to which Swiss production in this sphere has succeeded in meeting the demands of fashion.

The irresistible tendency of clothes to become more and more practical, of « dressy » fashions to adopt styles and materials which are less and less formal (inspiring women to adopt the pullover for evening wear) has contributed much to increasing the success and reputation of knitted wear.

This fashion is interesting from the point of view of industrial economy because it has made possible the development of the knitting and hosiery industries in certain districts of Switzerland, far from the traditional centres of textile production. The manufacture of knitted fabrics is in fact much simpler technically than that of other fabrics and can therefore be carried out on a small scale independent of the subsidiary industries so necessary to weaving. Thus factories are found not only in northern and eastern Switzerland, but even in the west of the country and particularly along the shores of Lake Lemán.

This comparative decentralisation brings in its turn certain appreciable advantages to the industry from the point of view of fashion. As a matter of fact it is well known that from one part of Switzerland to another tastes differ greatly, especially where clothing is concerned. Nearer in spirit to France and Paris, to which it is bound by many affinities, French Switzerland manufactures different models to German Switzerland; thus each district interprets the fundamental ideas of fashion in its own way, according to its own conception. Of course the differences are very small and they are hardly noticeable when one model is compared with the next, but they can nevertheless be felt when production is viewed as a whole. Swiss collections of jersey and knitted wear are therefore extremely rich and varied, and are well able to satisfy the most widely different tastes, the contrasting trends of mentalities which differ from one latitude, from one climate to another.

It must also be remembered that Switzerland is a country for sport, tourism and study. The passion of the population for the open-air, an active life and sports of all kinds has compelled industrialists to manufacture models which are not only elegant but at the same time practical and strong; the presence in the country of a great many foreigners from all parts of the world — both tourists and students — only serves to emphasize this requirement, while bringing to the creators of these models

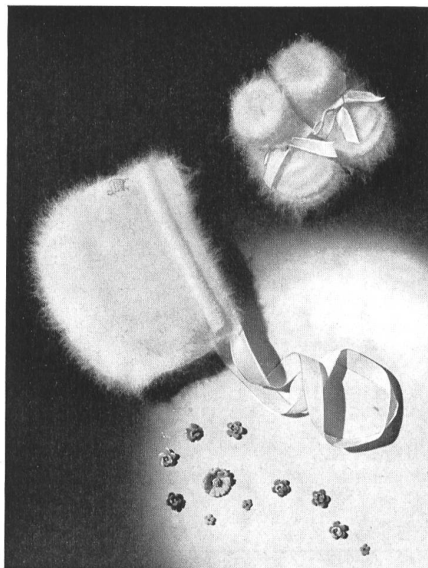
