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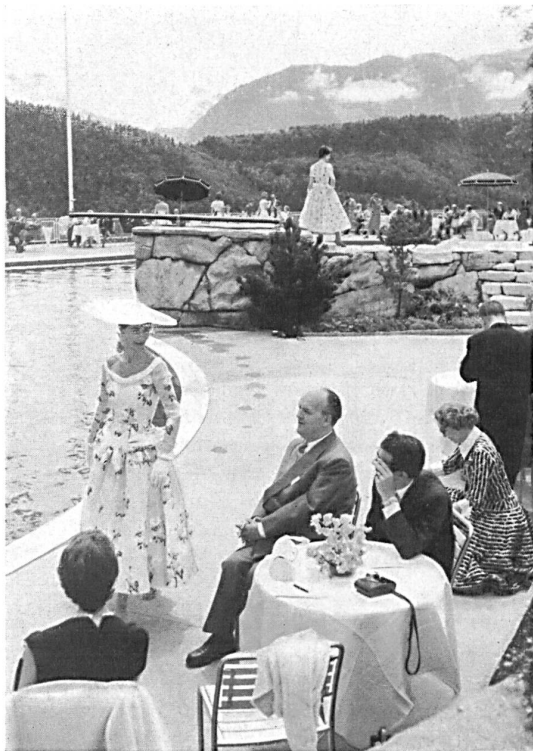
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A weekend of fashion



The setting for this delightful weekend of fashion was the Burgenstock, a verdant promontory jutting out from the mountainside and overlooking the Lake of the Four Cantons some 1,300 feet below. The guests also included commercial attachés of different countries, the heads of the big Swiss textile associations and other personalities. The first parade «Elegance and Quality» presenting dresses, suits, coats, footwear, jewellery, etc. took place on the Saturday evening at a ball which followed dinner, while on Sunday, summer fashions and sportswear were shown at the open-air swimming pool. Lingerie, fashion articles for men and children, and footwear were also on display. The whole weekend was perfectly organised and a great success.
