WOOL, perennial favourite for the springtime

The Zurich office of the International Wool Secretariat (IWS) organised an exhibition and fashion parade in February this year entitled « Wool, perennial favourite for the springtime » for the purpose of showing the press, retailers and the general public the role that wool can and does play in clothing for the spring.

In all latitudes spring is, in fact, the most capricious of seasons and the one — as statistics go to show — with the biggest and most sudden variations in temperature. Wool, an elastic living fibre with a high capacity for thermal insulation, is therefore admirably suited to the making of clothes which, while being light, comfortable and favourable to cutaneous respiration, afford at the same time effective protection against sudden drops in temperature, are strong, keep their shape and ensure a perfect fit. The wearing of wool in springtime is all the more justified today as Swiss woollen mills produce high quality fabrics of great elegance and worthy of the finest creations of the Swiss ready-to-wear clothing industry; as for the jersey and knitwear industry, it enjoys a world-wide reputation today and makes models for all occasions.

This was made very clear to all who attended the exhibition by the displays of artistically arranged woollens and the fashion show. On this occasion, the International Wool Secretariat benefited by the collaboration of the Swiss Association of the Wool Textile

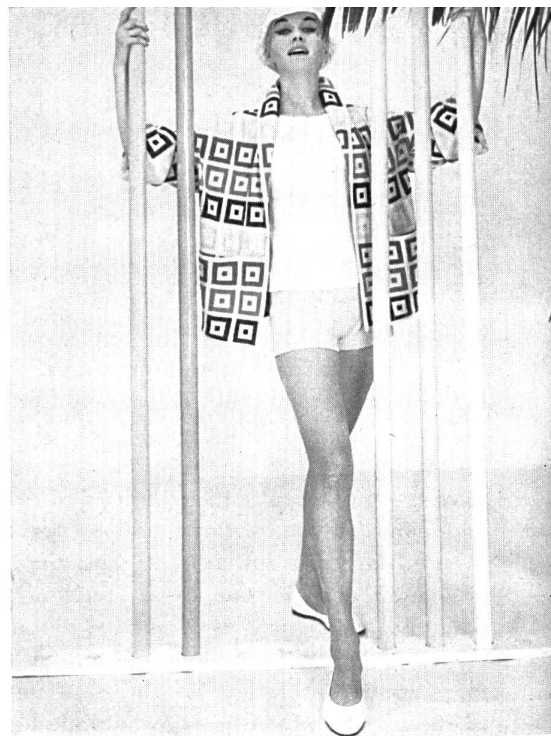

We reproduce here some of the many models admired during this display.

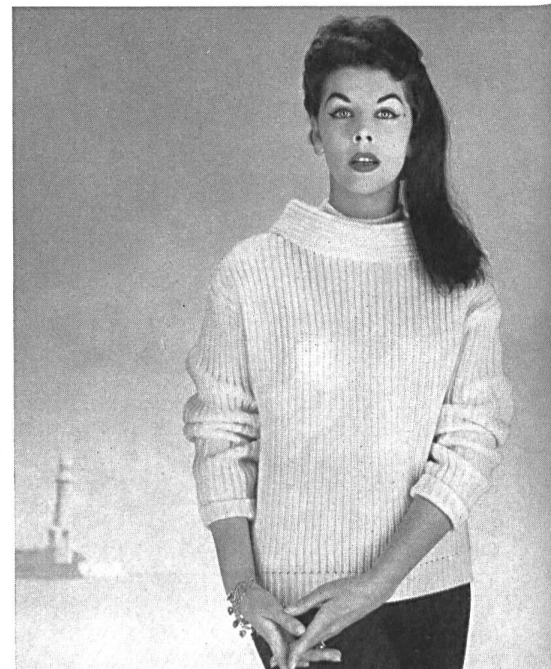

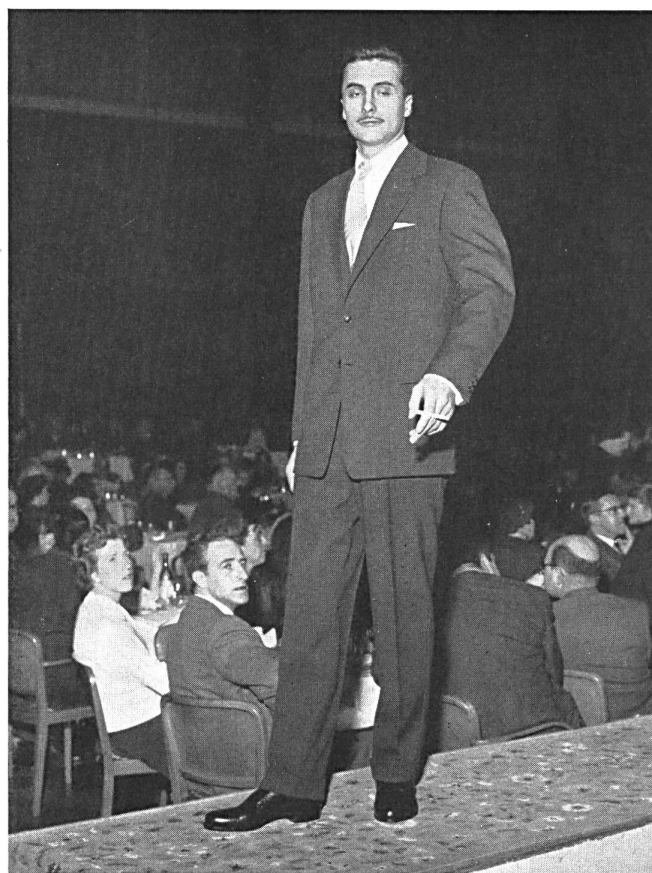
