Orlon, the acrylic fibre, produced in the United States by Du Pont, is imported into Switzerland only in fibre form. Here it is spun and twisted into yarns which are then used by Swiss weavers, knitters, hosiery manufacturers, etc.

The fashion display organised in Zurich this November by the Swiss firm representing orlon fibre, the Synthetic Products Company in Zurich, consisted exclusively therefore of Swiss-made articles such as pullovers and cardigans, skirts, coats, trousers, sports outfits, jackets, children's underwear, dressing gowns, swimsuits, beachwear, afternoon and town dresses in knitwear and fabrics, cocktail and evening dresses in fabrics, etc. It is impossible to give a complete list here of the many firms who work with orlon fibres at one industrial stage or another — spinning, weaving, knitting, etc. — nor can we attempt to mention all the ready-to-wear firms that use orlon fabrics.
