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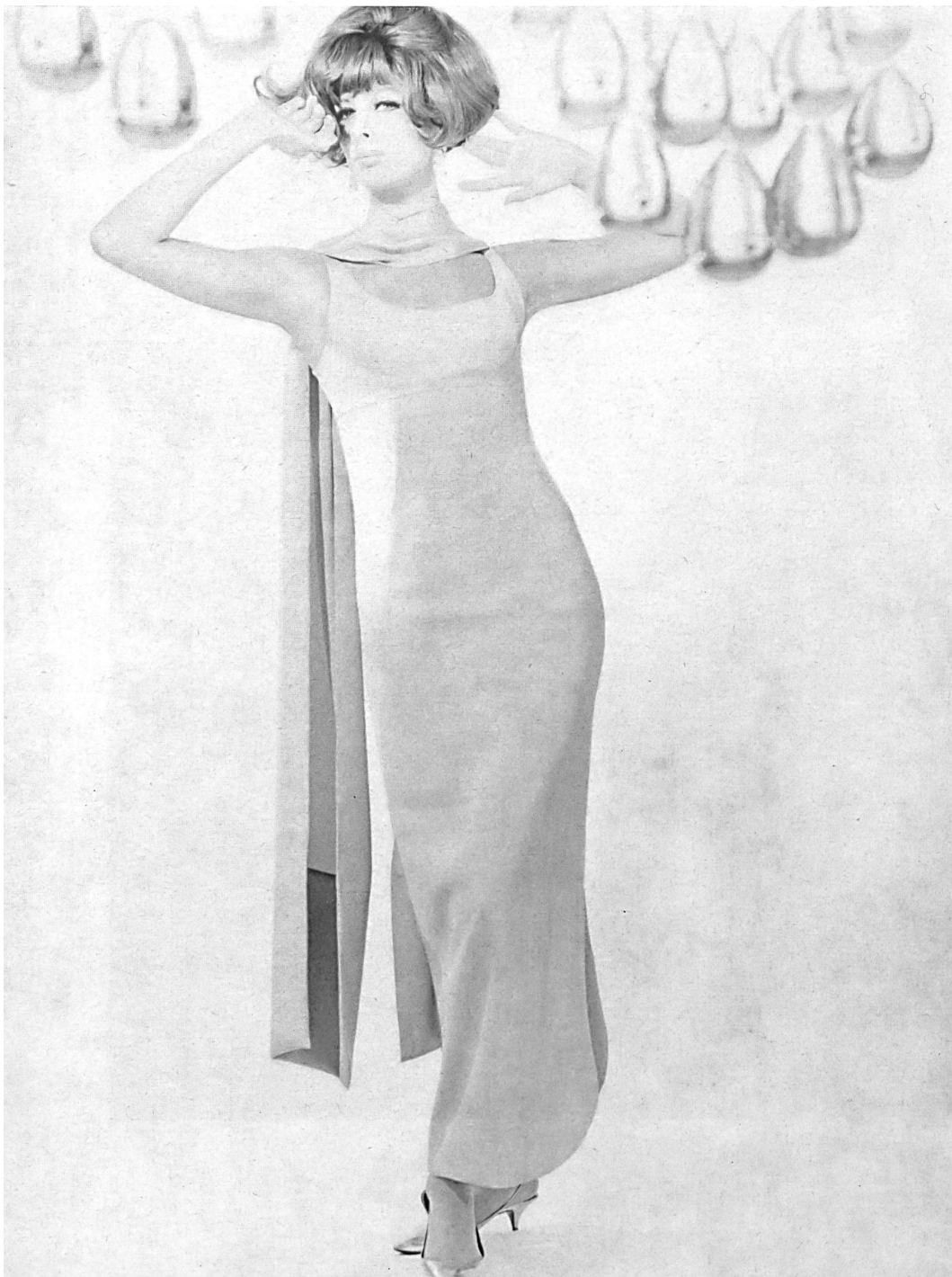
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Collaboration at the Technical Level

This summer, the Association of Swiss Textile Specialists, the Association of Former Students of the Textile Vocational Training School at Zurich and the Swiss Association of Dye Specialists brought their members together for a technical information meeting with the theme « Closer Collaboration between Textile Technics and Textile Finishing ». It was the first time that three professional associations of this importance had organized the joint discussion of professional problems. Textile

specialists showed considerable interest in the event, some 500 of them attending the meeting in the Congress Palace.

Mr. N. Bigler of the Textile Microscopy Laboratory of Ciba S. A. at Basle spoke first of all the subject « Practical Textile Microscopy », then Mr. A. Eugster, of Heer & Co. Ltd. of Thalwil spoke about « Fashion, Marketing and Textile Technics », followed by Mr. N. Gyr of the Gugelmann Company at Langenthal, who discussed the
